

8 PRAYER WATCHES

NIGHT WATCHES

First Watch (6:00pm - 9:00pm):

A Time of Quiet Reflection/Release of your Future (Matthew 14:15-23)

- Time for the divine beginning (Genesis 1:5, 8, 13).
- Time to release and proclaim into the new day God's blessings, changing the environment or spiritual equation in our life, family, church, city and nation (Psalms 28:6-9, 118:24, Numbers 6:24-28).
- This watch is for seasoned Christians having a strong Apostolic calling and anointing to break strongholds and walls and who are determined to do mighty things with boldness in the Lord (Isaiah 61:1, Mark 1:32, Luke 4:18, 40).
- Time for Covenant Renewal with God (Jeremiah 31:34-34, Ezekiel 36:24-28, Joel 2:28-32).
- Time for the Manifestation of the Nature of the Lamb of God (Revelation 5).
- Time for Preservation of the Fruits of our Life (Psalms 128:2, Romans 6:22).

Second Watch (9:00pm - 12:00am):

Visitation/Acts of Change

- Time to hallow and exalt the name of the Lord Jesus (Psalms 23:1, 59:16-17, Matthew 6:9, 10).
- Special time for divine favour. This is the time to receive your provision or supply such as strength, abilities and freedom from all limitations (Exodus 3:21-22, 11:3-4, 12:35-36, Psalm 5:12; 45:12; Esther 2:9, 15, 17).
- During this watch, intercessors are able to impact the spiritual realm before the enemy gets ready to wreak havoc (Psalms 68:1-4).
- Pray for Divine Protection (Psalm 3:1-7, Acts 23:23, & Zechariah 1:10).
- Pray for provision to do God's Work (Exodus 11:3-4).

Third Watch (12:00am - 3:00am):

Spiritual Activity

- The midnight watch is a time for spiritual warfare due to sleep resulting in decreased prayers to oppose Satan and heightened satanic activities (1 Kings 3:20, Exodus 12:29, Judges 19, 2 Kings 19:35, Matthew 13:25).
- This watch calls for seasoned intercessors who already know how to use their spiritual armor and war against the enemy (Mark 16:18, Luke 10:19). Intercessors obey the voice of the Lord and saturate this time with powerful Spirit-led prayers.
- A special time for divine governments overruling human decrees (Genesis 11:1-9, Daniel 5:21).
- A time of release from every prison: Samson carried away the gates of Gaza at midnight (Judges 16:3-4), Paul and Silas were released from prison at midnight (Acts 16:25).
- A time of angelic visitation (Exodus 12:29, 2 Kings 19:35); A time when the wicked are wiped out (Isaiah 37:36).
- A time to make your case in prayer and for emergency provision from God (Luke 11:5-13).
- A time to speak peace and calm into every situation of turbulence and confusion (Psalms 91).

Fourth Watch (3:00am - 6:00am):

Angelic Release/Command Angels

- This is the last watch of the night and is a special time for divine judgment released on the wicked (Job 38:13, Proverbs 29:1).
- The time that those satanic agents who went out to perform their activities are returning back to their bases.
- This is also the time for deliverance, to rise and shine, for resurrection: God released the Children of Israel to leave Egypt during this watch (Exodus 12:31-32; Jesus came walking on water to release the Disciples from the storms (Matthew 14:25; commanding your day and speaking into your life (Isaiah 60:1-5, Psalms 19:2, Job 22:27-28).
- The time for resurrection power when we pray that everything that has died in the body of Christ, in terms of potentials, should be released (Psalm 18:28).

DAY WATCHES

First (Fifth) Watch (6:00am - 9:00am):

A Time of Declaration & Utterances & a Time When God Strengthen Christians

(Acts 2:15 & Psalm 2:7-9)

- The spiritual significance of sunrise is having Jesus Christ, the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords, rise over us (Malachi 4:2).
- A time to be equipped by the Holy Spirit for service (2 Corinthians 9:3; Ephesians 4:12)
- The outpouring of The Holy Ghost came during the first watch at the third hour (9:00 a.m.) of the day (Acts 2:4, 15, 17-18).
- Regular work schedules usually begin between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 9:00 A.M. As you step out, ask God to equip you for the day.
- During this watch, pray for such issues as healing in your body, relationships, family, government, and the economy.

Second (Sixth) Watch (9:00am - 12:00pm):

The Exit and Entry Watch & a Time of Harvest

- Time to see God's promises fulfilled in your life (Exodus 12:35-36, 2 Samuel 7:25-29, Acts 2:41).
- Time to reflect on the power of the Cross (healing, prosperity, forgiveness, healing of relationships, strength) (Mark 15:25, Matthew 27:45, Acts 2: 1-8).
- Pray for a crucified life (Romans 8:12-15, Colossians 3:2-11).
- Pray for the release of others (Matthew 6:12).

Third (Seventh) Watch (12:00pm - 3:00pm):

The Watch of Shaking of Foundations & Judgment (Isa. 7:14)

- This is the Watch that introduces the midday, otherwise known as the noon, or the sixth hour or the fullness of day (Psalm 55:17).
- This is the time that the promises of God are released, foundations are shaken, and to exercise your God-given dominion (Deuteronomy 33:4, Proverbs 4:18).
- Time of the secret place of the Most High (Psalm 91:1)
- Time to pray against destruction that strikes at noon time (Psalm 91:5, 6, 14, Psalm 92:6-7).

**Fourth (Eighth) Watch (3:00pm - 6:00pm):
The Transformation Watch (Luke 23:45-46)**

- This Watch ushers in and begins at the hour of prayer according to Acts 3:1, Acts 10:30 and Isaiah 60:1122.

- The Hour of Prayer, Covenant, Power and Triumphant Glory (Luke 23:45-46).

- Time to change and shape history. This was the time God changed history because this watch happen to be the time that Jesus Christ gave up the Ghost with a loud voice (Zechariah 1:10-11, 18-21, 1 John 1:7).
